“NO THANKS” MEANS “NO THANKS”

If you have trouble with this concept, we'll be glad to explain it to you. If you encounter someone who is having trouble understanding this concept, please make a staff member aware.

SHARE PUBLIC SPACES RESPECTFULLY

Treat others as you would expect to be treated. Demeaning, pushy, forceful and abusive behaviour toward fellow patrons or staff is NOT acceptable. Sexual activity (with or without a second party) is not permitted on the ground floor or in shared public spaces.

CLEANLINESS AND VANDALISM

We go to great lengths to provide a fully functional and clean environment for your enjoyment. Any form of vandalism or any unhygienic acts will not be tolerated. If you see (or smell) this happening, report it immediately to staff.

LICENSED PREMISES

Food, drink or alcohol can NOT be brought into the venue as dictated by local council and licensing laws.

SECURITY

All areas of the venue are CCTV monitored for your safety and security.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside the venue. The courtyard or sun-deck are available for this purpose.

ALCOHOL

We have a strict policy of serving alcohol responsibly. Alcohol, high temperatures and wet areas don't mix well. So please **DRINK IN MODERATION!**

DRUGS

Possession, consumption or trafficking of any illegal substance is strictly prohibited. You won't need to explain yourself to staff... You WILL be explaining yourself to the authorities... No exceptions...

SAFE SEX

Take home a hot guy or a hot memory, not an STD. We strongly encourage safe sex. Prevention... Cure... You know the drill. Condoms are provided. Use them...

WATER RESTRICTIONS

It's a precious resource. Please keep your shower times to a minimum. We'd hate to have to change our business name to... Dry?

Failure to respect this Code of Conduct can result in you being asked to leave the venue. Failure to leave the venue when asked will result in you leaving the venue under Police escort.

We're constantly striving to make your visit a memorable and enjoyable experience. Whilst our staff are continually trying to make this happen, they can't be everywhere at once. Please help us by informing staff if you witness breaches of this Code. The sooner we are made aware, the sooner we can act. Your assistance will be greatly appreciated.

In addition to our Code of Conduct, the following information may also be useful:

TOWELS are located in your locker upon arrival. A second towel is available at the front window if required during your stay. Any further towels are available on request at the front window at \$1.00 per towel. Used towels can be placed in the chute provided in the entry hall on your way out or when grabbing a fresh one.

PASS-OUTS are available if you need to leave the premises temporarily. They must be used by the expiry time and/or date shown. Please remember that a re-entry fee of \$4.00 applies when returning on a pass-out. Only one pass-out is permitted per day for each fully paid entry. If you do have one, keep it safe. If lost, you will be required to pay full entry price to re-enter the venue.

LOCKERS are provided for you to safely store your belongings whilst on the premises. Make smart use of them. **DO NOT LOSE YOUR KEY!** Don't leave it lying around and don't let it out of your sight. Not only are your belongings at risk if you do lose it, but you will be charged \$20.00 for replacement of the key & the barrel. If you have misplaced it, **LET A STAFF MEMBER KNOW IMMEDIATELY!!!**

LOST/STOLEN PERSONAL PROPERTY should be reported to staff immediately. Whilst we have taken every care to ensure your belongings are safe during your visit, it is ultimately your responsibility to look out for your own gear. We take NO responsibility for items lost, stolen or damaged whilst you are on the premises. Security Cameras are positioned in all areas of the venue, so report anything suspicious immediately.
